



SNACKS (MERIENDAS)

While in Spain, Merienda means a "light meal," in the Philippines it is used as a catch-all term for any snack enjoyed between meals.

LUMPIA 12

Five crispy, fried Filipino style eggrolls filled with beef, soy sauce, veggies

VEGGIE LUMPIA 12

Five all-veggie Filipino style eggrolls. They're Vegan!

SIOPAO (SHOW-pao) 10

Two steamed rice-flour buns with meat filling

LECHON KAWALI 12

Crispy, deep-fried pork belly with dipping sauce

ENTREES (ULAM)

Ulam has many different meanings and uses, but essentially, Ulam is the items in a meal that are eaten together with rice or noodles or the entree

PANCIT (STIR FRIED NOODLES) 12

Traditional Noodle Dish w/Veggies
Add Protein: Chicken Adobo, Pork BBQ Skewers, Lechon Kawali or Shrimp

CHICKEN ADOBO 12

Chicken marinated in soy sauce and spices, pan-fried and stewed until tender. Served over rice or noodles

FILIPINO PORK BBQ SKEWERS 12

Thinly sliced marinated pork on 2 bamboo skewers. Served with rice or stir fried noodles

BRUNCH(SILOG) WEEKENDS ONLY

Filipino breakfast "Silog" is a combination of two words – sinangag, meaning garlic fried rice, and itlog, meaning egg.

Add Lumpia to any Silog meal for \$2 each

LONGSILOG longanisa sausage, garlic rice, and fried egg and fruit 12

TOCILOG Tocilog- Tocino (cured pork), with garlic rice and fried egg and fruit 12

SPAMSILOG Spamsilog- SPAM®, garlic fried rice and a fried egg and fruit 12
